





... but just **one** of those killings was caught on camera.





# Investigative Methodology

Who interviewed – notes, tape, location, statement

# Investigative Methodology

## False Confessions

Prior utilization of and testimony by informant (case number, name of the prosecutions)

Case names and numbers of any trials or evidentiary hearings cooperating witness has testified concerning his own prior criminal activity

Prior testimony of informant on themes material to his service as an informant

Any ledger, sheet or other document details sums paid, cooperating witness or his family purpose of each payment

Any information, whether or not memorialized regarding promises of immunity, leniency, preferential treatment or other inducements made to cooperating witness or any family member

# Investigative Methodology

## Confidential Informants

Information or records concerning actual or implied threats of investigation by prosecution to witness or family member (motive)  
Statement, information or documents that conflicts with other witnesses statements  
Name, current whereabouts witnesses not going to call to trial, copy of statements  
Reports documents, information details criminal activity without approval

Information reflecting nature and extent of assets obtained in connection with illegal activities for the past 10 years

Any records – show witness given

- Code names

- False identity

- Reasons for cooperation

- Given polygraph exam



On January 12, 2013, Pennsylvania State Police engaged Stephen R. Gracey in a dangerous vehicle pursuit near Scotland in Franklin County, P.A. Police were able to disable Gracey's vehicle; tackling and slamming him facedown to the ground. During the assault, some PA state troopers watched on while others restrained him. Several troopers piled on top of Gracey after he was down, one trooper admitted to striking him with a closed fist and kneeling him in the back.

# Federal prosecutors routinely got a look at documents selected by defense for copying, motion says

A copying service routinely gave Miami federal prosecutors CDs containing documents flagged by the defense for trial preparation, according to a May 26 motion filed on behalf of a doctor charged with health-care fraud.

The [motion](#) says the materials are classic attorney work product, report the Wall Street Journal [Law Blog](#), [Above the Law](#), the [Florida Bulldog](#) blog and the [Southern District of Florida Blog](#). The service has provided the tagged defense documents to federal prosecutors for at least 10 years, according to the motion filed by Black, Srebnick, Kornspan and Stumpf.

The defense team is asking a judge to toss the indictment against physician Salo Schapiro or to disqualify the prosecution team.

The copying service makes copies of discovery documents for lawyers in federal fraud cases after they review and flag them at a government warehouse. Defense lawyers say they first learned of the issue when federal prosecutors revealed an FBI agent had copied materials from four CDs made for the defense.

When defense lawyers checked with the director of the copying service, he said the practice of cloning the defense documents for the government had been done at the request of an agent of the government and had been going on for at least 10 years, the motion says.

The U.S. Attorney's office counters in a [brief](#) filed last Thursday that there has been no showing that the documents were protected work product and "certainly no willful or purposeful violation of any work product protections."

The federal prosecutors say the CDs were never requested by anyone on the government's behalf, and the prosecutors in the case weren't aware of the duplicate CDs until they were disclosed in April.

An investigation has so far found "that there was simply no pervasive practice of receiving or






